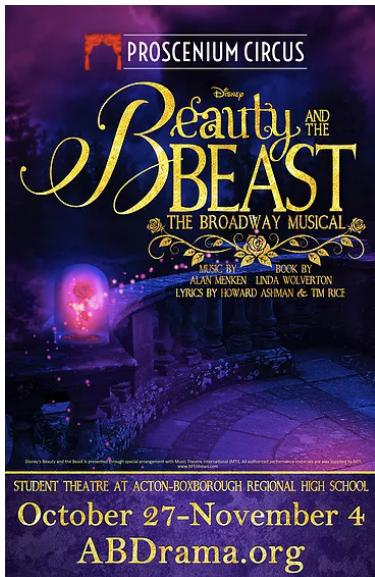


ABSAF Sports, Clubs, & Activities Update
